

SPRATTON TOWN AND CHARITY LAND ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2020

In accordance with the aims of the Charity we were able to give grants totalling £6480 at the end of 2020. Thirteen students from the village benefitted with help towards the cost of their books and equipment. Nine of the village organisations also received help towards their different projects.

In addition we donated £2000 to the Church over and above the normal constitutional amount of £2450. This was to help the Church who has received very little income during the last year due to Covid restrictions.

The Trustees were gratified by the number of letters they received from most of the recipients of the grants.

All organisations and students are encouraged to apply for a grant and an application can be obtained from the clerk. This year applications need to be received by the end of October.

The Trustees look after the land used for allotments including hedges, pathways, fencing and gates. The maintenance of the land is paid for by the rents from allotments and fields in trust to the Charity.

We have had a successful year letting plots to new tenants and, at the moment, we have just one full plot vacant.

The cost for a plot (100ftx25ft) will be £30 from September 2021. If anyone is interested in renting please contact the clerk or any of the Trustees.
