Requested better, more economical and environmental streetlighting	Replaced streetlights with LED lights, reducing electricity bills
Continue with the village bus service when facing cuts to the service	Engaged with other local parishes and WNC to ensure bus service could continue
No longer a youth club in the village	Provide a youth club in the village ran by CYPN
Reduce speeding in the village	Purchased and maintained speed cameras in the village
Monitor crime levels in the village and act to reduce crime	PCSO initiative entered into with other local villages
Improve the Millennium Garden area	PC worked with local volunteers to improve the area and installed two new benches in partnership with Broomhill
Engage with Broomhill and raise concerns on village behalf	PC set up quarterly meetings with Broomhill to address and identify problems. Encourage integration with the community. Established open lines of communication between the village and Broomhill.
Improve health and safety issues such as dog waste bin outside of the Primary school	PC have raised this issue with Local Authority, and the PC have arranged and paid the cost of moving this bin.
Streetlight outside of Primary School	PC have been working on a way to light this area better. They will be engaging with Local Authority to try to find a solution
Support local organisations	PC grant money to the REC for mowing and maintenance
Keep the local area looking presentable and a nice place to live	PC manage the mowing contractors and maintain the churchyards
Find ways of maintaining Spratton's history	PC Adopted the red phone box and made into a swop shop.
Engage the community	Competitions ran with local school and photo competition in newsletter. Attended and supported REC village festival and litter picks. Correspondence with local primary school on issues important to them.
Village defibrillators	Installed and maintain village defibrillators
Address highways problems	PC liaise with Highway to ensure problems are reported and actioned. Meetings on site attended and actions followed up.
Hearses finding access gate too narrow at cemetery	PC in conjunction with Bonhams funeral directors undertook work to widen the gates
Traffic in village concerns especially around school times	Council liaised with schools and LA to ensure school users aware of dangers, and LA provided additional signs
Improvements to the REC skate ramp	PC contributed financially to this work.
Better more accessible website	PC up-dated the council website to ensure accessibility requirements met
Road signs need repainting and cleaning	PC liaised with WNC and Daventry district to ensure this work was undertaken. Cllrs cleaned some signs themselves to ensure a quick response.

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Planning regulation and animal welfare concerns in the village	PC ensured concerns were sent to relevant departments at WNC and followed up
Salt bins to be decommissioned	PC adopted a salt bin that would no longer be kept in working order by WNC. PC maintain this bin.
Help village arrange a local group for Ukraine refugee support	PC worked with community to arrange a meeting for the village to support the settlement of Ukraine refugees, and support interested parties through the process.
Help support the local Primary School fund raising for Ukraine	PC paid for the hire of the village hall
